All participants 'turn off' their voices and use only sign language in an effort to improve receptive and expressive skills. 'Voices off' begins Friday evening after a brief orientation and continues with entertainment and socialization. Saturday consists of morning and afternoon workshop sessions - and we make sure you get breakfast in the morning and a social luncheon in the middle of the day!

WE LEARN

Workshops will be offered at various skill levels.

Participants may choose any workshop they want and are encouraged to challenge themselves while at the ASR by attending workshops that will allow them the most benefit possible. **Workshops are presented in ASL with no voice interpretation.** To receive CEU/EIC/IIC credit, the participants must be present for the entire workshop. NO credit will be given for partial attendance.

The following definitions will be used for ASR workshops and participant classifications:

BEGINNER - ASL 1 and 2 students, students with little or no prior knowledge of ASL/Deaf Culture

INTERMEDIATE - ASL 2 and 3 students, those with basic understanding of simple concepts in ASL and able to have introductory conversations.

ADVANCED - ASL 3 & 4 students, those fairly conversational in ASL.

INTERPRETERS - Working and /or certified interpreters, those comfortably fluent in ASL

EIC/IIC/RID CEUs can be earned in all workshops

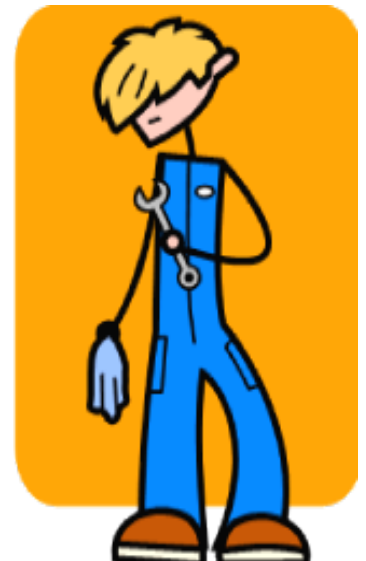
