This workshop will explore the possibilities of using CDIs in a classroom setting. Participants will analyze situations in which a CDI would be most helpful for clarifying information presented in the classroom. Participants will also learn about language modeling and how it effects the ability of a student to develop language that would apply to, and enhance, all academic efforts. Participants will also discuss strategies for approaching administration to establish guidelines and protocols for using CDIs in the classroom

Carol-lee Aquiline was born in Pittsburgh, PA . She has lived in Sydney, Australia; Geneva, Switzerland; Ferney-Voltaire, France; Stockholm, Sweden and Helsinki, Finland. She has worked in the theatre arena as well as holding the office of General Secretary of the World Federation of the Deaf. Carol-lee returned to the USA in 2005 and adopted a Russian son in 2006 . She is a fluent user of American Sign Language (ASL), Australian Sign Language (Auslan), British Sign Language (BSL), Swedish and Finnish Sign Languages as well as reading and writing English; and some Swedish; Spanish and French. She is currently a Deaf interpreter who holds her IIC and is a candidate for the national RID Certified Deaf Interpreter Certificate. She teaches ASL locally and, via distance learning, at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College in Richmond Va. Carol-lee also serves as an advocate, trainer, mentor, inspirational speaker and ASL tutor.
